- 1. A born again believer with a growing relationship with Christ; Exhibits an ongoing devotion to prayer and studying the Bible
 - a. Sometimes we forget to pray, sometimes we forget to read the Bible, but as a worship team we are dedicating our gifts to a higher spiritual purpose.
- 2. A faithful pursuit of leadership characteristics as listed in 1 Timothy 3; Maintaining a high moral and ethical lifestyle; A growing maturity of character
 - a. We all fall short and we all fail, but if we're going to be part of this worship team we need to hold ourselves to a higher standard.
- 3. A strong desire to serve God; A genuine love for people and willingness to maintain a good rapport with them
 - a. Ultimately, what we do every Sunday is not about us. We are representatives of God, so when we speak let us speak with His words and when we see the world let us see it with His eyes.
- 4. Attitude demonstrating genuine care and patience (especially in rehearsal situations)
 - a. God cares for you and me, and He has great patience with us. Let's look to do the same for our fellow team members.

 - a. This is including styles that you may or may not be familiar with. As a musician you're never too old to learn new musical ideas or new ways to do them.

 - a. When we come together for rehearsal, we're looking to tighten things up as a band. You're expected to know your parts for all songs in the set before we rehearse together.
- 7. Experience and comfort with use of computer systems and software (i.e. Planning Center Online)
 - a. Don't worry, if you know how to use a smart phone you have all the experience you need to have. Our major form of communication is through Planning Center. They have so many great tools to utilize, you'll just need to get comfortable with that app.
- 8. Regularly attends Sunday service and scheduled team meetings; Present and active in the life of the church
 - a. You play an important role on and off stage. If you call NBCC your home church, then don't hesitate to be part of the fam.
- 9. Self-awareness in personal life at home and public; Representing yourself and the church
